Known as Boston's Beloved Radio Voice, Candy O is a member of the Massachusetts Broadcasters Hall of Fame. An award-winning radio broadcaster, podcaster, master interviewer, and singer, her music has been played around the world. She and her daughter Colleen are the co-authors of the illustrated children's series, Nelson's Garden.

A 25-year veteran of Magic 106.7/WMJX, Candy is the Founder of My Dove Productions and the Candy O Radio Network. She's the host of The Story Behind Her Success weekly podcast and syndicated radio series, The Speaker Coach podcast, 16 Life Lessons Motivation Monday feature, and the Nashville-based podcast series Country Music Success Stories. Candy is a regular contributor to Pink Chair Storytellers Magazine.

Chosen by her peers as the 2015 Massachusetts Broadcaster of the Year, Candy O has interviewed nearly 1000 women from every walk of life and is the recipient of 70 local and national awards for excellence in women's programming.

Born in New York City and raised in Connecticut, Candy came to Boston to compete as a 1-meter diving champion for Boston College. She serves on the Council for Women of Boston College, The Pink Rose Foundation and Dream BIG. A lifelong advocate in the fight against breast cancer, Candy became a breast cancer survivor in 2024 and is the recipient of the Ellie Popkin award from The Ellie Fund. In April, 2025 she launched the Sweet Melissa Fund to honor her lifelong friend's dying wish to provide emergency help to women in crisis in their hometown of Newington, Connecticut.
